Respiratory Detoxification

The Homeopathic Pharmacopoeia Convention of the United States defines nosodes as "homeopathic attenuations of: pathological organs or tissues; causative agents such as bacteria, fungi, ova, parasites, virus particles, and yeast; disease products; excretions or secretions." Isopathic remedies share a close relationship with nosodes, however, they emphasize substances taken and potentized from the patient's surround such as environmental toxins, metals, imponderables, etc. Detoxifiers presented in this section are a combination of classical homeopathic preparations in a 60 mL cobalt blue bottle (protects the remedy) which may include nosodes, isodes, sarcodes and potentized botanicals all designed to differentiate, constellate and amplify the keynote focus of the remedy. All ingredients are made from mother tinctures, hand diluted as per Hahnemann and hand succussed. Many are in multiple potencies known as homaccords to provide for the processes and patterns of homeopathic ascendancy. *Potentized Mesenchyme 6X, 9X, 6C and ATP 5X are included to assist in homeopathic ECM drainage and homeopathic empowerment.*

When toxic chemicals are released, either through industrial or agricultural processes or consumer products, they make their way into the body through the lungs, skin and/or mouth. Once absorbed through these various routes, they enter the blood stream and are carried around to different parts of the body. Chemicals are then either stored in tissues, like fat and bone, or are metabolized by the liver and excreted through urine, the lungs, sweat, semen, milk, saliva and bile.

Hormone disrupting chemicals, such as brominated flame retardants (BFRs) and phthalates can mimic, block or interfere with hormones such as estrogen, androgens and the thyroid, resulting in reproductive defects, reduced fertility and neurological, behavioural and developmental problems.

Neurotoxic chemicals fall into three main groups: 1) heavy metals and metal compounds 2) solvents and 3) other simple organic compounds and pesticides. These chemicals cause damage to the brain and can lead to developmental and behavioural disabilities, particularly in children, because their brains are still developing.

When respiratory toxins are inhaled, they affect the nasal passages, pharynx, trachea, bronchi and lungs. These toxins cause both acute and chronic illnesses such as Bronchitis, pulmonary fibrosis, emphysema, Cancer, and general breathing problems. As irritants, respiratory toxins can also increase the severity and incidence of respiratory infections and can aggravate asthma.

Reproductive toxins can affect reproductive ability and sexual function. Examples of reproductive disorders that may be caused by these toxins include endometriosis, failure to

ovulate normally, tubal pregnancies, miscarriages and stillbirths, low sperm count and motility, undescended testes, hypospadias and testicular Cancer.

Persistent compounds are not easily broken down in the environment and thus stay in air, water and soil for a very long time—increasing the likelihood that they may be absorbed or ingested by people. As new persistent chemicals are created and released, there is an increase in the variety of pollutants that will be sticking around for decades, building up into quite the toxic soup.

Chemicals that bio-accumulate, increase in concentration in the tissues of living organisms at higher levels than those found in the surrounding environment. These chemicals are very slowly metabolized and excreted. They tend to build up in the tissues of living organisms, as they are drawn to biological fluids and fatty tissue. Toxic chemicals differ in terms of their persistence and capacity to bio-accumulate. They include chlorinated hydrocarbons, such as DDT, PCBs and dioxins distress the respiratory capacity.

Multiple homaccords for the most common respiratory irritants, including industrial, environmental and beauty salon toxins, are included to assist in their removal at a deep, cellular level.

Pneuma-Tox is a powerful homeopathic remedy specifically designed to assist in the resolution of toxins associated with the lungs and respiratory system.
